The beauty of our genuine engineered European Oak is in its natural variations of colour and grain, complimenting the natural knots that run through the floorboard. By highlighting these unique characteristics of European Oak in the finishing process, the Lavanda Oak collection is ideal when it comes to exuding a luxurious feel in any project, opening up a world of options for colour palettes in paint, décor and styling.

The prefinished 1900mm x 190mm x 3/14mm T & G board is finished with a UV lacquer ultra matt finish whilst the cross-layer construction of the multi-ply core allow the boards to maintain stability even over radiant heated subfloor systems.

Newly implemented is the ultimate Sherwin-William coating system, which provides an ultra-clear coat to the floorboard, providing a more scratch resistant process. Furthering this is the ultima sealing on the surface, which provides 48 hours* (*conditions apply refer to Lavanda Oak Collection warranty) of water resistance.

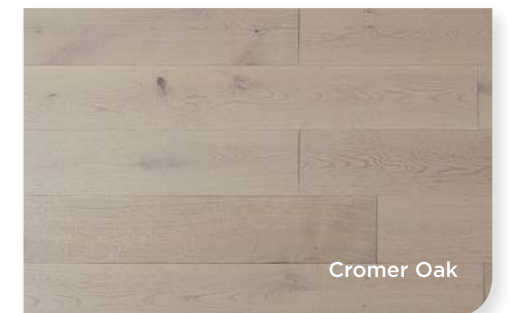

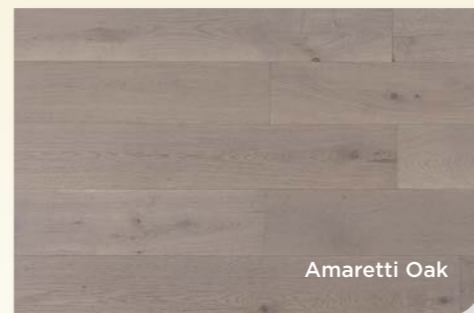

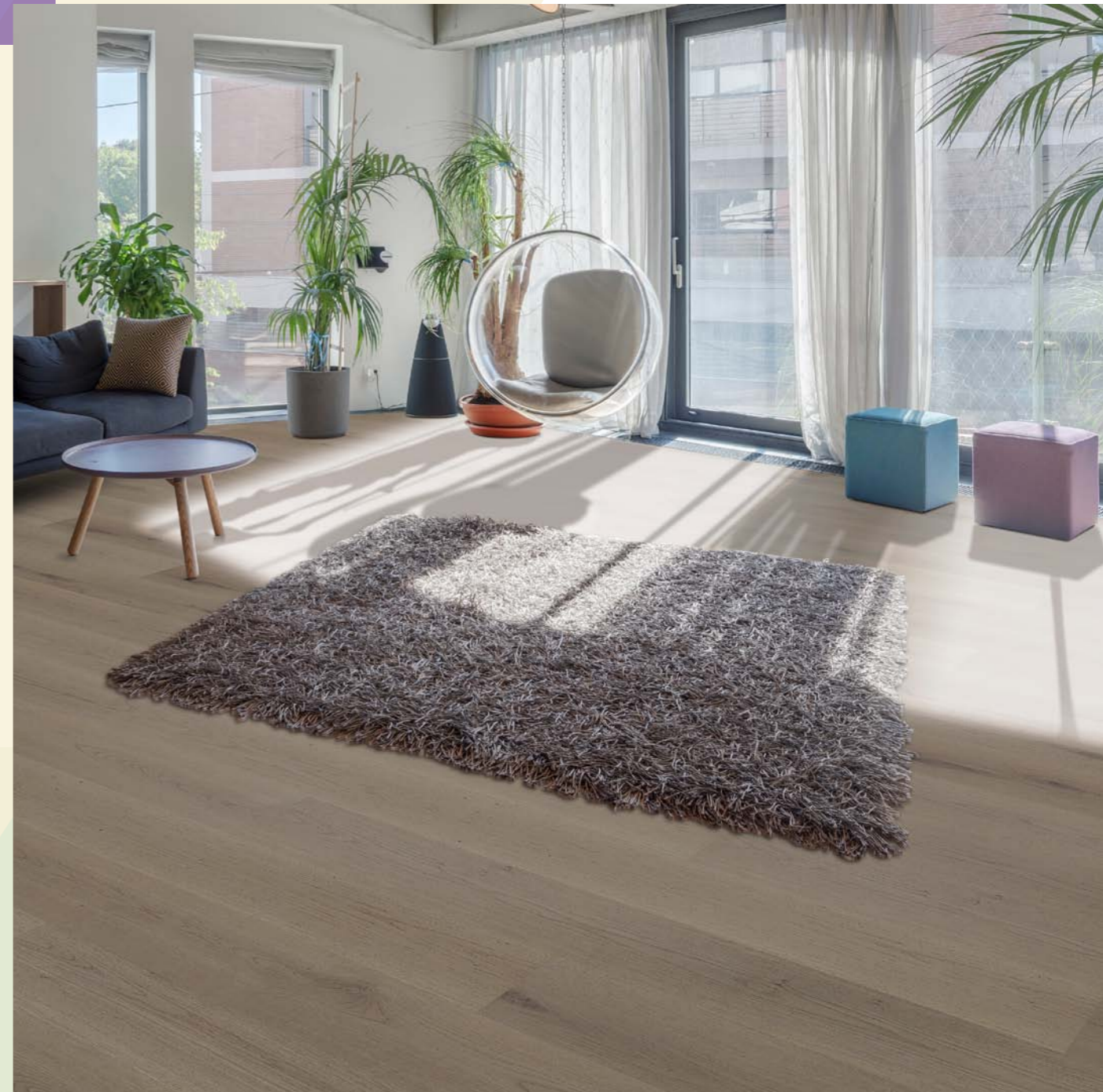


702 Amaretti Oak

A refined colour, Amaretti Oak's warm brown tones which shift toward a noble grey are able to compliment almost all interior styles.

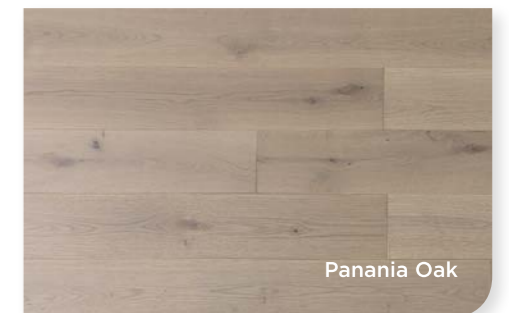

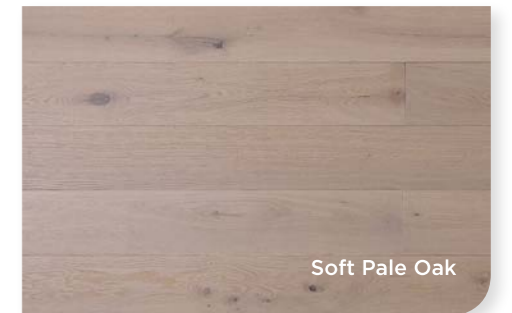

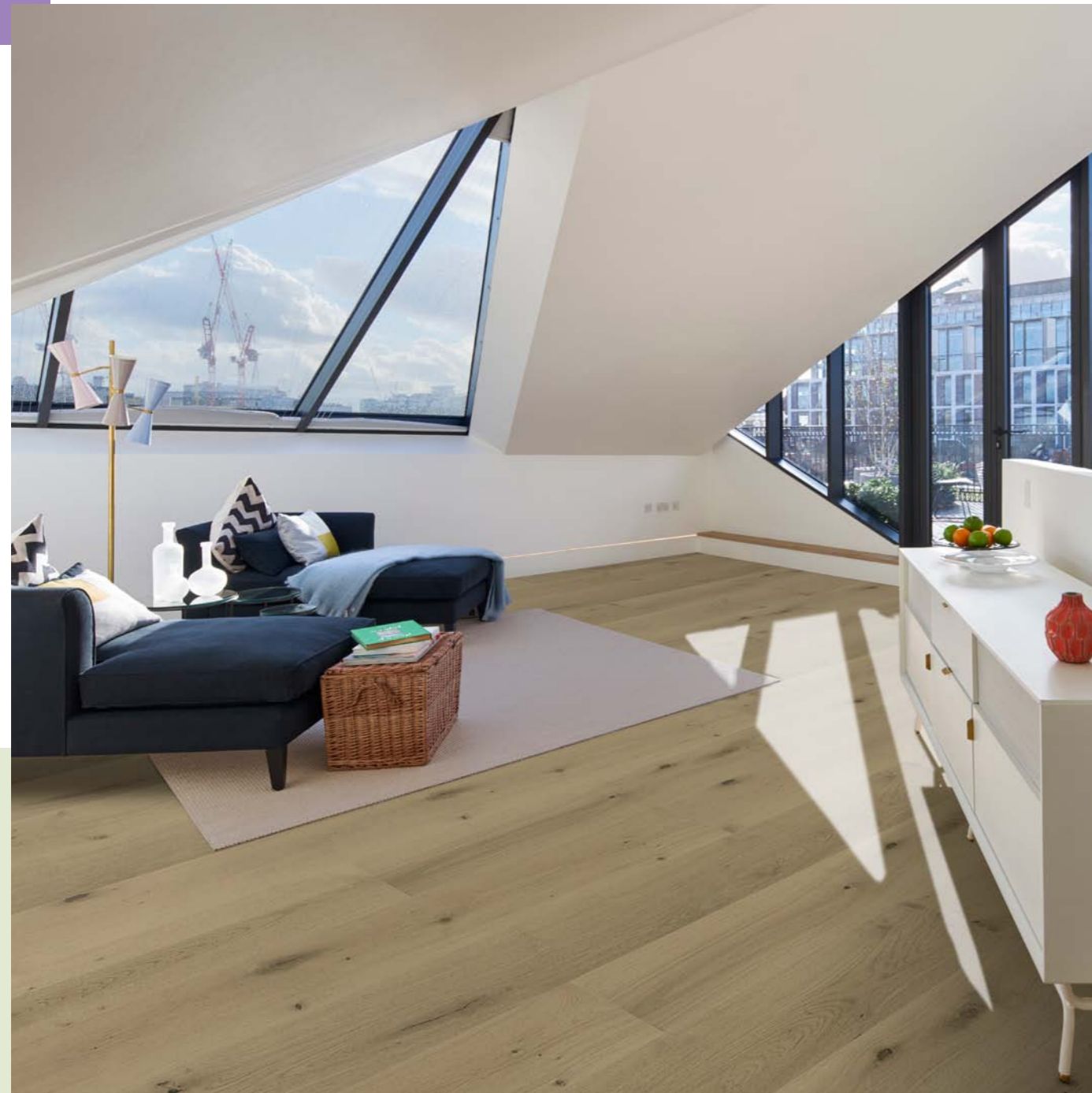


705 Soft Pale Oak

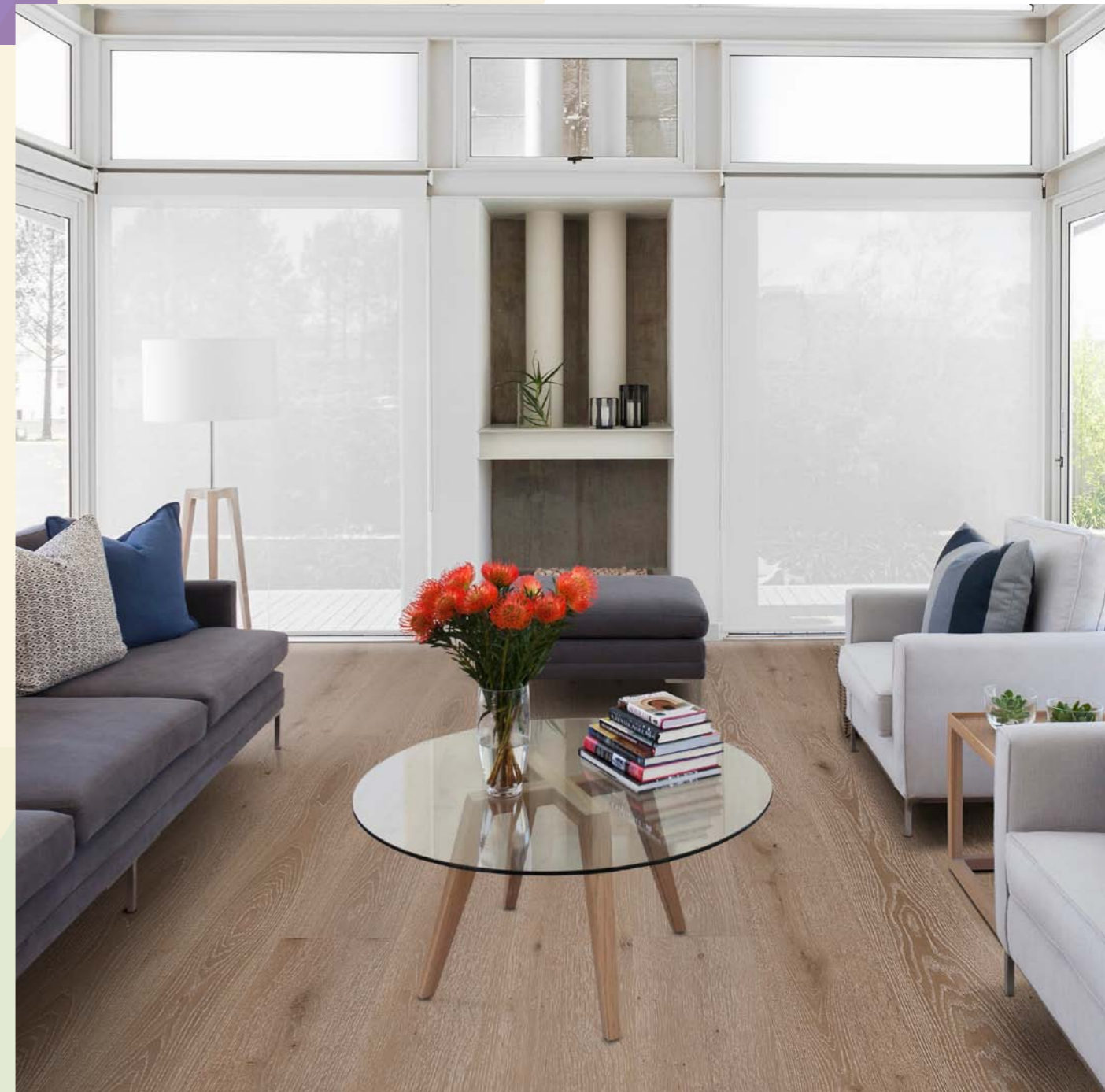


706 Champagne

A traditional oak floor that brightens any interior style, Champagne's cream colour and matte lacquer adds complexity to any home.

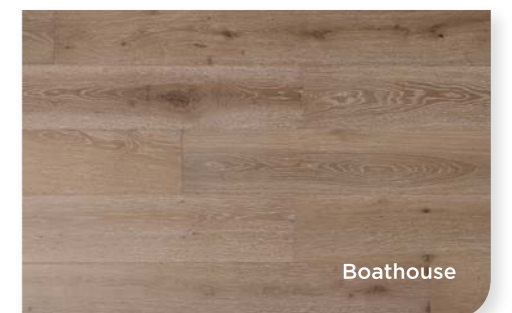
